3. Promotion of Quality and Sustainable Built Environment

3.1 Green Building Award (GBA) 2019

Green Building Award 2019 was co-organised by the Hong Kong Green Building Council (HKGBC) together with PGBC and it has been a major event in Hong Kong and the region since 2006. With the theme of “Inspiring the Next Generation · Excellence in Sustainable Built Environment”, overwhelming response was received and 67 Finalists had been selected for the Final Judging.

PGBC was invited by the Buildings Department, the HKSAR Government to provide comments for the Consultancy Study on the Review of the Mechanism for Encouraging a Quality Built Environment through GFA Concession.

7. SDG Eco Village – Transitional Social Housing Project
